<u>Competition regulations - European Championships.</u>

The games for the European Championship are shot according to the WSA regulations. (For this we have to take into account the Belgian legislation).

<u>Attention</u>: shooting is not permitted outside the designated installations, not even outside the event hall. (under penalty of exclusion!)

- All competitions are completed indoors.
- Distance until the targets for adults is 10 meters.
- Distance until the targets for the youth-series is 8 meters.
- For safety reasons, we have to shoot in a designated installation.

In each of these spaces, 2 WSA stands are set up.

There are 4 of these installations, which makes a total of 8 targets set up.

- All catapults with a maximum width of 25 cm are allowed, except those with arm and/or wrist support.
- No infrared equipment, no rifle scope.
- No mechanical release device.
- 'Frameless' shooting is not allowed.
- Round steel balls are used as ammunition, with a minimum size of 6.35 mm and a maximum size of 9.55 mm.
- All ammunition te be used must be placed in the place provided for this purpose.

 Ammunition may not taken from a vest or trouser pocket, or other bag.
- Behind each shooter there is a referee who will record each shot.

👃 Saturday July 26th - European Championship Individual

*The competition starts at 1:00 PM.

*The match is divided into 3 phases:

- preliminary round
- semi-final
- final
- **The preliminary round:
 - All participants.
 - 4 rounds on the ranges with variable targets, 5 shots Diameter of the goals, and points:

-8 cm 2 points
 -7 cm 4 points
 -6 cm 6 points
 -5 cm 8 points
 -4 cm 10 points

maximum 4 x 30 points

- 1 round on the ranges with 5 targets of 4 cm, 5 shots

**<u>Semi- final :</u>

- The first 50% of the shooters from the preliminary round.

(the participant(s) with the same score as the last of those 50% will also compete in the semi-final)

- Diameter of the goals, and points:
 - 4 cm 10 points per hit.
- Each participant shoots 2 turns of 5 shots.
- The participant shooses to shoot the targets from left to right or from right to left.
- The chosen direction must be communicated to the referee in advance.

 This applies to all series in the semi-finals and the final rounds.
- When a target plate is missed, the next target must be shot. Hitting an incorrect plate is considered missed and no points are scored for this. The target plates are put back upright: the score already achieved is retained.

Finals:

- The resultats of each round, the preliminary and the semi-finals, will be added toghether in the finals.
- Diameter of the targets, and the points:

- 4 cm 10 points each hit.

- 1 round each time.

- First finalround MEN: - The 32 shooters with the highest total score.

(the participants with the same score as no. 32 shoot an extra round to eventually have 32 shooters left. Multiple rounds can be completed for this. These extra rounds

consist of 5 shots).

This method will be used in each subsequent round to start the next round with the required number of shooters.

- Second round : - The top 24 after the first round.

- Third round : - The top 16 after the second round.

- Fourth round : - The top 8 after the third round.

- Fifth round : - The top 6 after the fifth round.

- Sixth round : - The top 4 after the fifth round.

- Seventh round : - The top 3 after the sixth round.

(This round determines the 3rd place)

- Round of 8, and final: - The top 2 after the seventh round.

- First finalround WOMAN: - The 16 female shooters with the highest total score in the

preliminary round.

(the participants with the same score as no. 16 shoot an extra round to eventually have 16 female shooters left. Multiple rounds can be completed for this. These extra rounds

consist of 5 shots.

This method will be used in each subsequent round to start the next round with the required number of female shooters.

- Second round : - The top 8 after the first round.

- Third round: - The top 6 after the second round.

- Fourth round : - The top 4 after the third round.

- Fifth round: - The top 3 after the fourth round.

(This round determines the 3rd place)

- Sixth round, and final: - The top 2 after de fifth round.

- first finalround YOUTH:

- The 8 youthshooters with the highest total score in the preliminary round.

(the participants with the same score as no. 8 shoot an extra round to eventually have 8 youth shooters left.

Multiple rounds can be completed for this.

These rounds consist of 5 shots.

This method will be used in each subsequent round to start the next round with the required number

of youth shooters.

- Second round : - The top 6 after the first round.

- Third round: - The top 4 after the second round.

- Fourth round : - The top 3 after the third round.

(This round determines the 3rd place)

- Fifth round, and final: - The top 2 after de fourth round.

Sunday, July 27th - European Championship Countryteams.

- The competition starts at 11:00.

- Each participating country has 1 team consisting of the first four participants of the country in the precision competition on Saturday. The list will be published on site and the participants cannot be replaced.
- Gender or age are not taken into account.
- The competition is shot on WSA stands, with targets of 4 cm.
- 2 Rounds are completed with 5 shots per participant each time.
- The points of the 4 shooters are added together.
- If there are equal scores for the first 3 places, an extra round will be completed with the teams concerned, until places 1, 2 and 3 are known.
